Students must wear full school uniform, as supplied by the SUB Shop.

Note: Students may wear the existing school uniform until the end of 2020.

Girls Uniform

	Item	How / when worn
Green Polo Shirt (short sleeve)	Green polyester polo shirt. OR Green cotton backed polyester polo shirt. (Both with College emblem embroidered on shirt).	May have all buttons done up or top button undone.
Green Polo Shirt (long sleeve)	Green polyester long sleeve polo shirt with College emblem embroidered on shirt.	May have all buttons done up or top button undone.
Black Shorts	Black polyester rugby shorts with KG emblem. OR Black poly cotton rugby knit shorts with KG emblem.	Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be worn out.
Black Skirt	Black poly cotton skirt with KG emblem.	To be worn at knee length. Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be tucked in.
Black Skort	Black poly cotton skort with KG emblem.	To be worn at knee length. Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be tucked in.
Red Polar Fleece Zip Jacket	Red fleece jacket with zip front and KG emblem.	To always be in good condition.
Black Track Pants	Black polyester cotton track pants.	Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be worn either tucked in or out.
Year 1 - 5 Reversible Bucket Hat	All Year 1-5 students must wear the microfibre reversible bucket hat, with the school badge embroidered on the front.	The badge is to be facing the middle of the student's front and the brim is turned down. The brim is one centimetre above the eye brows.
Prep Red Broad Brimmed Hat	All Prep students must wear the red broad brimmed hat, with the school badge embroidered on the front.	The badge is to be facing the middle of the student's front and the brim is turned down. The brim is one centimetre above the eye brows.
House Polo Shirt	Polyester/cotton blend polo shirt in house colour. Worn only for Sports Days and house Cup activities.	May have all buttons done up or top button undone.
Shoes	Plain black leather closed in shoes or plain black joggers.	Shoes are to be worn with laces tied in a bow. No colour other than black to be visible.
Socks	White cotton socks, with or without the College emblem.	Need to be large enough so that the sock is seen above the shoe.
Hair Adornment	The only hair adornment is red or green ribbon, headband or clips in red/green.	It must be worn over hair ties that are similar to the student's hair colour.

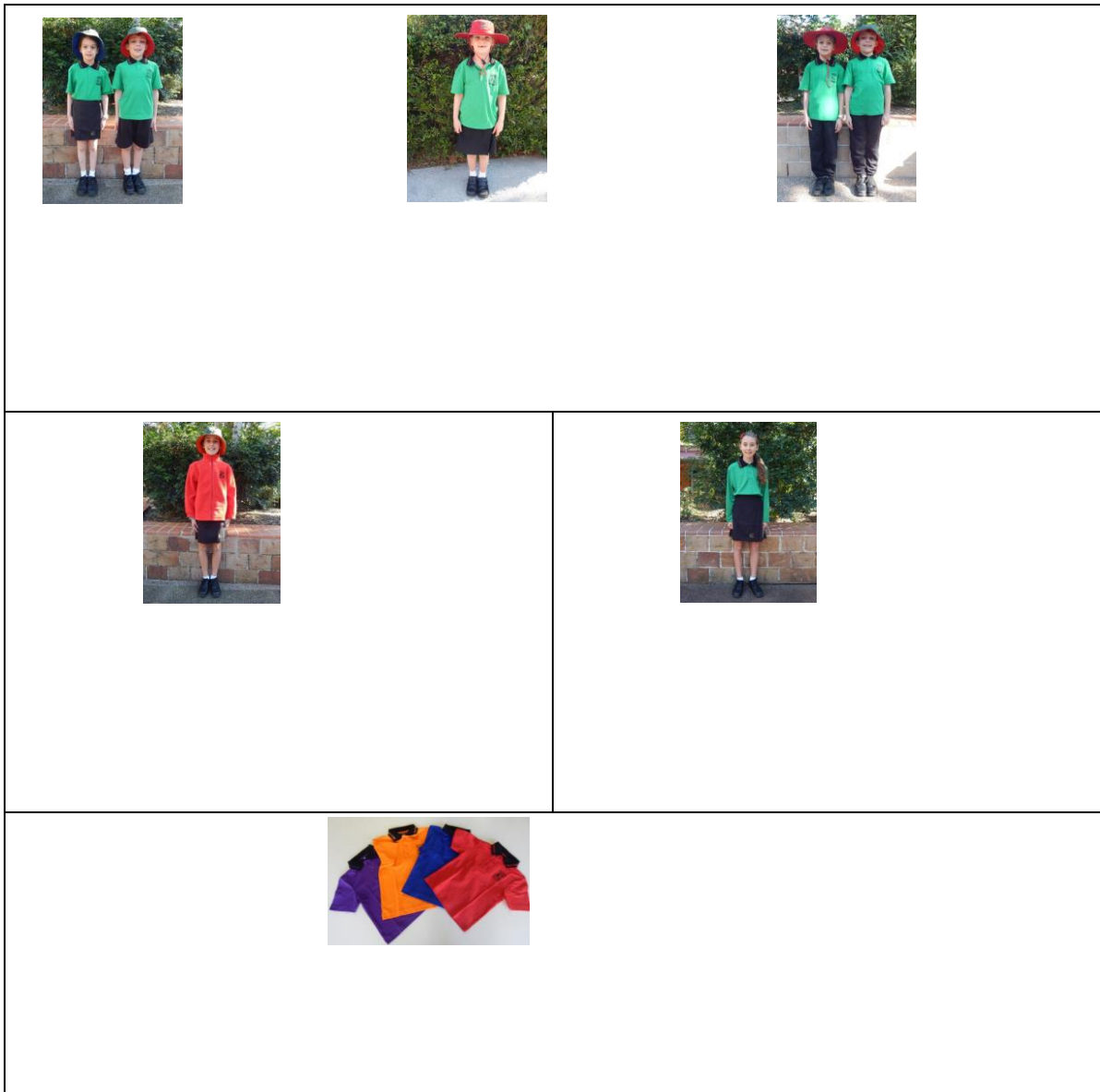
Boys Uniform

	Item	How / when worn
Green Polo Shirt (short sleeve)	Green polyester polo shirt. OR Green cotton backed polyester polo shirt. (Both with College emblem embroidered on shirt).	May have all buttons or done up or top button undone.
Green Polo Shirt (long sleeve)	Green polyester long sleeve polo shirt with College emblem embroidered on shirt.	May have all buttons done up or top button undone.
Black Shorts	Black polyester rugby shorts with KG emblem. OR Black poly cotton rugby knit shorts with KG emblem.	Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be worn out.
Red Polar Fleece Zip Jacket	Red fleece jacket with zip front and KG emblem.	To always be in good condition.
Black Track Pants	Black polyester cotton track pants.	Worn on the waist. Polo shirt to be worn either tucked in or out.

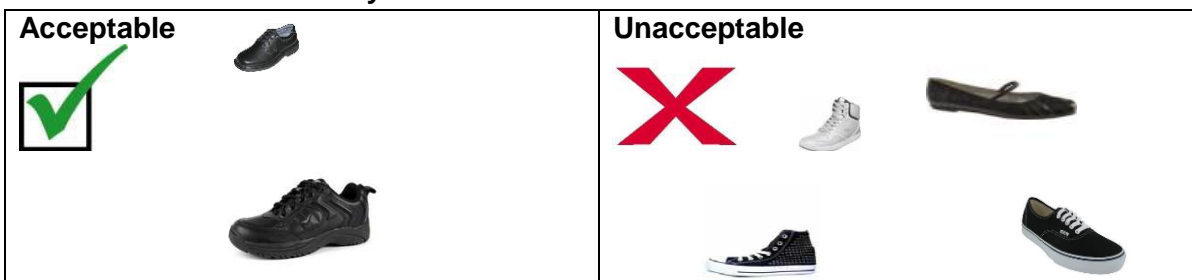
Year 1 - 5 Reversible Bucket Hat	All Year 1-5 students must wear the microfibre reversible bucket hat, with the school badge embroidered on the front.	The badge is to be facing the middle of the student's front and the brim is turned down. The brim is one centimetre above the eye brows.
Red Broad Brimmed Hat	All Prep students must wear the red broad brimmed hat, with the school badge embroidered on the front.	The badge is to be facing the middle of the student's front and the brim is turned down. The brim is one centimetre above the eye brows.
House Polo Shirt	Polyester/cotton blend polo shirt in house colour. Worn only for Sports Days and house Cup activities.	May have all buttons done up or top button undone.
Shoes	Plain black leather closed in shoes or plain black joggers.	Shoes are to be worn with laces tied in a bow. No colour other than black to be visible.
Socks	White cotton socks, with or without the College emblem.	Need to be large enough so that the sock is seen above the shoe.

Junior School Uniform

Boys and Girls

- **Hats** - Students must wear the reversible bucket hat (Year 1-5) or red broad brimmed hat (Prep) for all outdoor activities. These are available through the SUB Shop and are compulsory. We follow a no hat, no play policy.
- **Shoes** - Plain black leather closed in lace up / velcro shoes or black joggers only. No thongs or ankle strap style to be worn at any time
- **Tights** - Black – Term 2 or 3 only. No knee high stockings or footless black leggings.
- **Jewellery** - Is not considered a part of the school uniform and is not recommended. Large necklaces, rings and bracelets are not allowed.
- **Hair** - Must be neat and tidy as attention drawing extremes of dress and appearance are not acceptable. Outlandish hair styles or unnatural hair colour (bleached or dyed) will not be permitted in the school. Students with long hair must tie their hair back, with red or green ribbons, headband or clips as the only adornment.

Procedure

- Uniform is to be worn as supplied by the SUB shop.
- Full uniform must be worn daily as well as when travelling to and from home.
- If there is a legitimate reason for a student being unable to wear the uniform, he/she is required to present a note from parent/s to the classroom teacher.
- Non-College jackets are not to be worn at any time
- Students keep warm in winter with non-visible, warm undergarments and the college red jackets

Non-Uniform Days

For the cost of a “gold” coin, the students of Kelvin Grove State College may come to school out of uniform once per term on an assigned day as per college calendar. Each Non Uniform Day is organised by the Student Representative Council (SRC). Monies collected are used by the SRC to support a range of projects.

The code of dress for Non Uniform Day:

- Students must be neat and tidy.
- T-shirts with inappropriate print/slogans are not permitted.
- Immodest clothing, e.g. bare mid-riffs, low-cut clothing, and sleepwear (pyjamas) is not permitted.
- Shirts must have sleeves – those with shoe string straps are not permitted.
- In keeping with Workplace, Health & Safety regulations, leather shoes must be worn to Science, Manual Arts and Home Economics classes (Middle and Senior School Students only).
- No open shoes with open toes or thongs are allowed.
- Normal college rules regarding make-up and jewellery requirements in practical areas must still be met.

Procedure

- Reminders of an impending Non Uniform Day will appear in Student and Staff notices and Newsletters. Students will also be reminded of the dress code on assemblies.
- On the day, SRC members/teachers will collect the gold coin (min. \$1.00) from each student who is not in uniform.
- Students dressed inappropriately are referred immediately to Sub-school principals and may be sent home to dress appropriately.
- Students who have chosen to come in school uniform for the day may still donate money if they wish.
- All money collected is sent promptly to the SUB shop.

Schools of Excellence uniform

- The official Excellence Uniform (not training uniform) is regarded as a sports uniform and therefore sports uniform rules apply. The complete uniform must be worn (any variation will result in detention and demerits)
- Green Excellence caps may be worn at any time.
- Excellence uniform may only be worn to or from the College when:
 - An early training session commences before 8.00 am
 - An afternoon training session finishes after 4.00pm
 - Outside of these specific times students are expected to change into their regular college uniform
- Excellence jackets are only worn at tournaments or for warming up, not with school uniform.
- If a student has Excellence in period 1 and physical education in either period 2 or 3, he/she may remain in their excellence uniform however must change back into formal uniform for period 4 – even if there is after-school training.

Junior School Lost Property

Please make sure that all articles of clothing and personal school equipment are clearly marked with your child's name. A lost property box is located in the covered play area in the basement of 'A' Block. There is also a lost property box in OSHC in C Block.

Kelvin Grove State College Dress Code

The Kelvin Grove State College P & C Association has established an appropriate uniform which is to be worn correctly every day. Students attending Kelvin Grove State College are required to maintain the highest standard of dress and grooming.

In addition to the information provided for the uniform of each sub school the following applies:

Boys and Girls Uniform

- For reasons of uniformity, all items with the exception of shoes (in the style specified), need to be purchased from our college's SUB Shop. Clothing is to be worn as supplied by the SUB shop, any changes, for example shortening of skirts, will not be approved.

Hair

- Hair must be neat and tidy as attention seeking extremes of dress and appearance are not acceptable. Outlandish hair styles or unnatural hair colour (bleached or dyed) will not be permitted in the college. The following are considered unacceptable:
 - unnaturally coloured hair; blue, green bright orange/red, purple etc.
 - hair done in spikes, dreadlocks, mohawk style etc.
 - hair that is shaved around the perimeters or in unusual patterns
- Students with long hair are encouraged to tie their hair back with red or green ribbons, headband or clips.

Hats

- In the Junior School students are to wear the KGSC reversible bucket hat (Year 1-5) or red wide brimmed hat (Prep) for all outdoor activities.
- Students in the middle and senior school are encouraged to wear a college hat for all outdoor activities. These are compulsory for HPE and Sport.

Jewellery

- Wrist watch.
- Two sleepers or studs per ear (inconspicuous).
- One plain finger ring, inconspicuous nose stud (not ring); necklaces need to be of sufficient length that they are not visible.
- No other jewellery is permitted.
- No other visible piercings are permitted.

Make-up and Nail Polish

- Light foundation and clear nail varnish are permitted.
- All other make-up and coloured nail varnish are not acceptable and should not be worn to school.

Shoes

- In the Junior School, clean plain black leather closed in lace up / velcro shoes or black joggers only.
- In the Middle and Senior School, clean plain black leather lace up school shoes – non laced black leather dress style shoes are permitted in the Senior School (refer to sub school specific information).
- Appropriate heel height for girls' shoes – approximately 3 cm. Mid and high-cut boots are not acceptable.
- Shoes for HPE/Sport may be a pair of sandshoes/joggers predominantly black or white in colour.

Ties

- Neatly tied with length to the belt. No non-college approved pins/badges are to be placed on the tie.

Winter

- No undershirts that are visible (at neck, sleeves or hip) are permitted. Singlets, very short sleeved undershirts or spencers are permitted providing they cannot be seen.
- College scarf only permitted (scarf is for Year 6-12 students only). No other scarves, beanies or gloves are permitted. Students keep warm in winter with non-visible warm undergarments, college jumper, jacket or blazer.
